The Importance of The Bible

The Bible: A Strange Thing

- Some have never read it
 - Some listen more to what is said about the Bible than to the Bible itself
 - Some have stopped reading it
 - Some read the Bible in ways that hinder familiarity
-

Biblical Illiteracy in our Society

- ❑ Only half of adults interviewed nationwide could name any of the four Gospels of the New Testament.
 - ❑ Just 37% of those interviewed could name all four Gospels.
 - ❑ Only 42% of adults were able to name as many as five of the Ten Commandments correctly.
 - ❑ Seven in ten (70%) were able to name the town where Jesus was born, but just 42% could identify him as the person who delivered the Sermon on the Mount.

Biblical Illiteracy in our Society

- ❑ 38% of Americans believe the entire Bible was written several decades after Jesus' death and resurrection
- ❑ 12% of adults believe that Noah's wife was Joan of Arc.
- ❑ 49% believe that the Bible teaches that money is the root of all evil.
- ❑ 75% believe that the Bible teaches that God helps those who help themselves.

2 Thessalonians 2:9-12 ESV

9 The coming of the lawless one is by the activity of Satan with all power and false signs and wonders, 10 and with all wicked deception for those who are perishing, because they refused to love the truth and so be saved. 11 Therefore God sends them a strong delusion, so that they may believe what is false, 12 in order that all may be condemned who did not believe the truth but had pleasure in unrighteousness.
